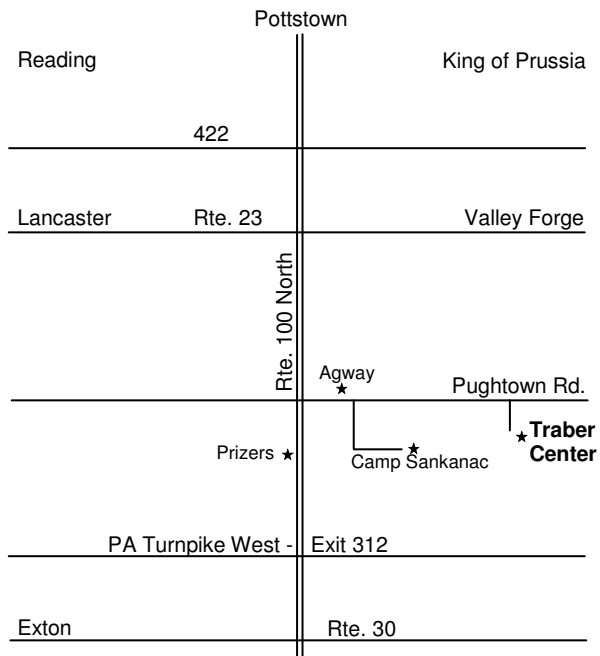
Directions to Traber Center

Located adjacent to Camp Sankanac in Chester County.

From Turnpike Take PA Turnpike to Exit 312 (Downingtown). Take Route 100 North, 9 miles to Pughtown. Turn right on Pughtown Rd. Turn at the second right (Traber Lane). Traber Center is at the end of the road.

From North (Allentown) Take Route 100 South for 6.5 miles south of Pottstown. Turn left onto Pughtown Rd. (1 mi. south of Rte. 23). Turn at the second right (Traber Lane). Traber Center is at the end of the road.

King of Prussia Take Route 202 South to Route 422 West. Pick-up Route 100 south, go 5 miles. Cross over Route 23. Go approx. 1 mile, turn left onto Pughtown Road. Turn at the second right (Traber Lane). Traber Center is at the end of the road.



Accommodations: Traber Center is nestled in a beautiful wooded, scenic section of Chester County, Pennsylvania. The motel style rooms sleep 3-4 with 2 twin beds and a twin bunk in each room.
